General Information for all Test Prep Classes

Each ACT Test Prep Session costs \$40. It consists of 4 classes. Students sign up for the class in the Counseling Office.

Students have experienced impressive test score gains from our classes. To achieve that same success, please follow these guidelines:

1. It is very critical that students attend all 4 classes in a test prep session. The four classes include a pretest, two classes of instruction that utilize the pretest as a teaching tool, and a post test.
2. Students need to bring two pencils and a calculator to each class. In addition, they should bring the pretest and the instructional workbooks to the second and third classes.
3. To receive the full benefits from the class, students need to be on time and attentive. We will ask you to turn off your cell phones during class.
4. There will be a short break in each class where students can eat food or drink they bring.
5. In addition to the four classes, students will have extra practice opportunities in the workbooks they receive.
