## Rules of Conduct

Cable Dahmer Arena is happy to share their facilities as a service to the community. The following rules of conduct are established for groups using their facilities and grounds:

- There will be no disorderly conduct in or around the facility.
- There will be no profanity or offensive language used by visitors.
- The use of tobacco, illegal drugs and alcoholic beverages in or around the facility is strictly prohibited.
- The possession of any weapon in or around the building is strictly prohibited.
- There should be no shouting or noise making devices of any kind in the facility. The most important part of the
  ceremony for all attending is to hear the name of the graduate. The reading of names <u>does not stop</u> for crowd
  disruptions. The LSW Class of 2024 would appreciate all guests' cooperation with this rule so all graduates'
  names can be heard.
- One ticket per seat. Toddlers & infants require their own ticket if they are not on the lap of an adult age limit
  for lap-seating is younger than 3 years of age.
- Caps may <u>not</u> be tossed, thrown into the crowd, on stage, or toward individuals. Following the presentation of the graduates, the entire class will toss their caps together.
- Graduates are not allowed to present anything to the R-7 Board Members as they receive their diploma covers.
- FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE RULES WILL RESULT IN GRADUATES HAVING DIPLOMAS AND/OR TRANSCRIPTS WITHHELD, AND NO ADMITTANCE TO PROJECT GRAD.
- The above rules of conduct must be followed in order for future classes to have use of the venue.
